## ABSTRACT

This publication is a translation of a Russian handbook of statistical tables on the economic and cultural development of northern aboriginal people in the Soviet Union. The handbook was prepared as background material for the delegates to the first Congress of Northern Aboriginal People of the USSR, which was held in Moscow on March 30-31, 1990. The Congress, comprising delegates representing the 26 northern aboriginal groups living in the Soviet Union, is the highest level decision-making body for the Association of Northern Aboriginal People of the USSR established in 1989.

This publication contains data on demographics, language, economic production, and standard of living. In many of the tables data are provided for each of the 26 groups of northern aboriginal people. .

## RESUME

Cette publication est une traduction d'un manuel russe comprenant des tableaux statistiques sur le développement économique et culturel des peuples autochtones des régions nordiques d'Union soviétique. Il a été conçu à l'intention des délégués présents au Premier Congrès des Peuples Autochtones des Régions Nordiques d'U.R.S.S., lequel a eu lieu les 30 et 31 mars 1990 à Moscou. Ce congrès qui rassembla les délégués des 26 communautés autochtones des régions nordiques de l'Union soviétique constitue le plus important corps décisionnel de l'Association des Peuples Autochtones des Régions Nordiques d'U.R.S.S. qui fut établie en 1989.

Cette publication comprend des données sur la démographie, la langue, la production économique, et le niveau de vie. Plusieurs tableaux renferment des données correspondant aux 26 communautés autochtones répertoriées dans la région à l'étude.

## Foreword

Beginning in the late 1980s it was becoming obvious that the Soviet political, social, economic, and cultural order was under attack. For those who travelled extensively in the Soviet Union during that period, it was apparent that significant change not only was necessary, but would happen in the near future. None, however, including the Soviet people themselves, could forecast the rapidity of the transformation which culminated in the tumultuous events during August, 1991. Although the upheaval at the present time has been primarily limited to the 15 Republics vis-à-vis their relationship with the Union, political and economic changes are also being asked for by residents of the individual republics themselves. In particular, Soviet northern residents who live in the Soviet North and whose borders fall exclusively within the Russian Republic are beginning to demand greater autonomy.

The Soviet North which extends over 10 time zones is very rich in natural resources and comprises over 11 million square kilometres or half the size of the entire Soviet Union. Until recently the administrative and political structure of this territory included 4 Autonomous Soviet Socialist Republics (each based on a predominant ethnic group), 2 Kraj (territory), 10 Oblast (regions or provinces), and 7 Avtonomnyj Okrug (each autonomous region based on a predominant aboriginal group). These political and administrative entities had different, but limited degrees of authority and autonomy, and were primarily controlled by the central, All-union authority and to a much lesser extent by the Russian Republic.

However, this centralized control over the Soviet North has also begun to unravel. As Mr. Yeltsin demands political and economic self-determination for the Russian Republic from Mr. Gorbachev, so are similar demands being made of Mr. Yeltsin by the various political and administrative entities within this northern territory. Autonomous Republics are calling for Republican status while lesser regional governments are asking for more recognition and political power, including Republican status. Throughout the Soviet North all northerners, including aboriginal people, are demanding a fairer share in the control of their destiny, be it political, cultural, economic or environmental.

It is the Soviet North which is and has been of interest to Canada because of its many similarities to the Canadian North, such as climate, geography, renewable and non-renewable resources and most important, the Soviet northern aboriginal people. In the Soviet northern territory there are 26 different aboriginal groups totalling approximately 185,000 mixed in with a population of 8 to 10 million, depending on the southern boundary of the Soviet North.

The Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development (DIAND) through the Circumpolar Affairs Division has since 1966 been following socio-economic and technical developments in the Soviet North in order to provide information to Canadian federal and territorial departments and non-government agencies. In addition, the Department has had the leading responsibility on behalf of the federal government for establishing relations with the Soviet Union dealing with

— the Arctic and the North. The prime results included the establishment and coordination of the 1984 Canada-USSR Arctic Science Exchange Programme, and the implementation through a Mixed Commission of the 1989 Canada-USSR Agreement on Cooperation in the Arctic and the North.

As a result, upon receipt of the Statistics on the Economic and Cultural Development of the Northern Aboriginal People of the USSR (for the period 1980- 1989) from Dr. Valery Tishkov, Director, Institute of Ethnology and Anthropology, USSR Academy of Sciences, a decision was made to translate the publication in order to provide a wider distribution of very interesting and unique statistics on Soviet northern aboriginal people. This information is the best that has been published to date concerning the northern aboriginal people. In fact, none of the Soviet Censuses published, including the 1971 Census, provide more detailed statistics on the Soviet northern aboriginal people as furnished by this publication.

The translated version was possible only because of the dedicated work and cooperation of three - key persons who were responsible in putting together this publication in English. We are particularly grateful to and acknowledge the contribution of

- Camil Simard, Circumpolar Analyst, Circumpolar Affairs Division, DIAND, for the initial translation and his persistence in resolving all the problems associated with the publication;
- John Hannigan, Project Manager, Centre for Canadian and Soviet Studies at Carleton University, with the support of the Dormer Canadian Foundation, for the final translation and editing of the text, the review of the statistical material with the original text and the introduction; and
- Bernadette Norwegian, Analyst, Circumpolar Affairs, Government of the Northwest Territories, who did an excellent job of transcribing all the data and setting up the format of the final publication.

In conclusion, we are hopeful that this publication will serve to provide information to those who are involved in studying socio-economic, political and cultural developments of Soviet Northern aboriginal people.

# THE ECONOMIC AND CULTURAL DEVELOPMENT OF THE NORTHERN ABORIGINAL PEOPLE OF THE USSR

## Introduction

The statistical tables contained in this publication were prepared as background material for delegates to the first Congress of Northern Aboriginal People of the USSR.<sup>1</sup> This Congress was held in Moscow on March 30-31, 1990 and received considerable attention in the Soviet media. The Congress, comprised of delegates representing the 26 northern aboriginal groups living in the Soviet Union, is the highest level decision-making body for the Association of Northern Aboriginal People. The Association was established in 1989 under the leadership of Vladimir Sangi.

This publication is believed to mark the first time that this amount of data on the economic and cultural development of northern aboriginal people in the USSR has been distributed publicly. Most had never before turned up in official statistical yearbooks of the USSR or RSFSR, or in the all-union censuses.

The publication contains data on:

- o demographics (e.g., population distribution by region and by sex, and natural population growth rates);
- o languages spoken as a mother tongue and as a second language;
- o production in regions inhabited by northern aboriginal people (e.g., industrial production per capita, output of furs, meat and dairy production), reindeer population, investment statistics, and average wage rates;
- o standard of living (e.g., food consumption, average living space, number of doctors and hospital beds, cases of tuberculosis, day-care facilities, higher education, bank savings, number of cinemas and telephones, etc.).

In many of the tables, data are provided for each of the 26 groups of northern aboriginal people. The data can therefore be compared among all groups. As well, they can be compared to figures provided for the RSFSR as a whole. In other tables, data are broken down by region

<sup>1</sup> In Russian, these ethnic groups are collectively called "malochislennye narody Severs" which translated means the numerically small peoples of the North. To indicate that these people inhabited what is now the northern part of the USSR prior to the arrival of Russians, the term northern aboriginal people is used here.

**provided** for the RSFSR as a whole. In other-tables, data are broken down by region (autonomous republic, kraj, oblast and autonomous okrug<sup>2</sup>) and by "regions inhabited by northern aboriginal people", a category which is unfortunately not precisely defined in the publication. This information is always contrasted with the corresponding **figure** for the RSFSR.

### Some Highlights of the Data

**Population:** According to census figures, the total population of the northern aboriginal people of the USSR in 1989 was 181,556, 0.06% of the total Soviet population and 0.12% of Russia's. The population of individual groups ranged from 34,190 for the Nentsy, to 179 for the Oroki. Thirteen of the groups each had less than 2,000 people.

**Population Growth:** Between 1979 and 1989, the population grew by 16.6%, or 1.5% at an average annual rate. This is a noticeably higher growth rate than the 2.9% (average annual rate of 0.3%) recorded between the 1970 and 1979 censuses. Growth rates vary considerably among the groups, ranging from a decrease of 15% for the Orochi, to an increase of 82% for the Itel'meny. Unfortunately, some of this data is inconsistent with other figures provided on natural growth rates (see the section below on "A Note on the Data" for a brief discussion of such anomalies.)

According to the data provided, the higher population increase in the 1980s is attributable to a steady rise in the annual natural growth rate (births minus deaths), from 1,522 in 1980 to 3,056 in 1988. In percentage terms, this marks a jump in the natural growth rate from approximately 1.0% in 1980 to 1.7% in 1988. As there are no data given for the natural growth rate during the 1970-79 period, there is no ready explanation for the low growth rate in that decade.

**Population Distribution:** Almost 95% of the northern aboriginal peoples live in Siberia and the Far East (that is, east of the Ural

Mountains). Roughly two-thirds live in four of the administrative districts in the Soviet North: Tyumenskaya Oblast (29%), Yakutskaya ASSR (13.7%), Khabarovskij Kraj (12.9%), and Magadanskaya Oblast (11.5%).

The majority of northern aboriginal peoples (74%) live in rural areas. This is down from 78% in 1979, indicating some rural to urban migration.

<sup>2</sup>The autonomous republic, kraj, oblast and autonomous okrug are administrative divisions in the USSR with different degrees of authority. They are all subordinate to the level of the union republic and to the union. The authority of these administrative units is currently being redefined as part of the overall transformation of the federal structure of 'the USSR.

Of the 1989 population, there were on average 113 women per 100 men. However, there were some dramatic variations by individual ethnic group. At the extremes, there were reportedly 87 women per 100 men among the Ents y, while for the Éveny there were 133 women per 100 men.

**Language:** According to the 1989 census figures, 52.3% of the northern aboriginal peoples considered their own language to be their mother tongue. And only an additional 3.2% had fluency in their own language as a second language. The percentage of northern aboriginal peoples having fluency in their native language fell from 65% in 1979 to 55.5% in 1989. In contrast, 1989 census figures indicate that 87% had fluency in Russian, either as a mother tongue (36.4%) or a second language (50.5%). This has happened despite the fact that between 1980 and 1989 there was an 82% increase in the number of aboriginal students studying their aboriginal language in schools.

**Economy:** Data on the economic activity "of northern aboriginal peoples are provided for several industries. In all cases, a figure is given for production "in regions inhabited by northern aboriginal peoples". These data can then be compared to those provided for the RSFSR and autonomous republics, oblasts, krajs, and autonomous okrugs in the North. At the most general level, the annual value of industrial production per capita for regions inhabited by northern aboriginal peoples was 2,499 rubles in 1988, which compared to 3,649 rubles for the RSFSR. Annual per capita industrial production in regions inhabited by northern aboriginal peoples spanned an exceptionally broad range, from a low of 188 rubles in Irkutskaya Oblast, to a high of 6,910 rubles in Yakutskaya ASSR.

Data are also provided on reindeer herds, fishing, fur production, arts and crafts, and meat and dairy production. Almost all of the reindeer in the RSFSR (96%) are located in regions inhabited by northern aboriginal peoples. During the 1980s, 10-11% of all state purchases of fur and 7-8% of the fish catch in the RSFSR came from those regions. (Recall that northern aboriginal peoples comprise only 0.1270 of the RSFSR's population.) For other industries, the share of the regions inhabited by northern aboriginal peoples in total RSFSR production are: arts and crafts - 0.5%; meat - 0.4%; and dairy products - 0.390.

**Indicators on Standard of Living:** A number of tables provide information on indicators of the standard of living in regions inhabited by northern aboriginal peoples, with comparisons to the RSFSR and its constituent administrative areas. There are data on capital investment in living space, schools and cultural houses which indicate that the regions inhabited by northern aboriginal peoples are currently getting a higher percentage of the total relative to their share of the population. Nevertheless, the average living space per person is still about 80% that of the RSFSR average.

The 1989 average monthly wage of 410.4 rubles in these regions is significantly higher than the 260 ruble average for the RSFSR. As a result, retail trade turnover per capita and the average size of savings accounts is higher than the RSFSR average. However, the provision of services is about 10% lower.
