EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report presents the estimated occupancy rates for Manitoba accommodation facilities for the second quarter of 1990. The estimates have been derived from the April, May and June Accommodation Occupancy Survey reporting forms.

In the second quarter of 1990, the average **total** occupancy rate for Manitoba accommodation facilities is 58.9%. **Facilit**^{*j*} es located in Winnipeg have an occupancy rate of 66.6% and **facilit**^{*j*} es located outside of Winnipeg have an occupancy rate of 53.2%.

Hotels/Motor Hotels have an occupancy rate of 58.6% -(65.9% for Winnipeg, 45.4% for Non-Winnipeg) and Motels have an occupancy rate of 52.6% (67.4% for Winnipeg, 49.0% for Non-Winnipeg).

Facilities with more than 75 units have the highest occupancy rates: 69.6% for Manitoba, 69.9% for Winnipeg and 67.4% for Non-Winnipeg locations.

Facilities with 0-12 units have an average occupancy rate of 30.2%, while those with 13-25 units have a rate of 47.4% and those with 26-75 units have a rate of 58.1%.

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MANITOBA ACCOMMODATION OCCUPANCY SURVEY

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
This report presents the estimated occupancy rates for Manitoba accommodation facilities for the second quarter of 1990. The estimates have been derived from the April, May and June Accommodation Occupancy Survey reporting forms. Estimates for 1989 are provided in certain tables for comparison purposes.

This report also contains data **on** the total daily room supply and the average number of rooms occupied per day for each month of the quarter.

Occupancy data is provided for Hotels/Motor Hotels, Motels and Cabins, by number of units (rooms) available: 0-12, 13-25, '26-75 and 76 plus.

Note, for 1990, facilities in the Accommodation Occupancy Survey are broken into four, rather than three size categories (ie. the 0-25 units group has been split into two groups, 0-12 units and 13-25 units). As a result, 1989 occupancy rate statistics provided in this report may differ slightly from those released in the 1989 quarterly reports.

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RELIABILITY OF OCCUPANCY RATE STATISTICS

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The estimated occupancy rates in this report are of varying degrees of accuracy (i.e., the size of deviations from the "true" occupancy rate which would have been obtained if all facilities had returned their reporting form). This is due to:

1. The response rate varying among various categories;

2. The small number of responses in some categories.

In general, it may be stated that the estimated occupancy rates will be more accurate in a particular category:

1. The higher the response rate;

2. The larger the absolute number of responses.

Therefore, on the above general accuracy criterion, we can make the following statements:

- Total Manitoba occupancy rates are more reliable than the regional occupancy rates;
- Within a geographic location (e.g., Winnipeg) the occupancy rates by Size Total (e.g., 13-25 all facilities) and Type Total (e.g., Motel, all sizes) are more reliable than they are by type <u>and</u> size (e. g., 13-25 Motels).

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1. OCCUPANCY RATES

- a) Total Occupancy Rate: The total percent occupancy, for a particular type, size and geographic location, estimates what percentage of the total rooms available for rent during the month were actually occupied.
- b) Average Number of Rooms Occupied: The average number of rooms occupied, for a particular type, size and geographic location, estimates how many rooms (accommodation units) were occupied on a daily basis during the month.
- c) Unit Nights Sold: The purchase of one accommodation unit for one night occupancy.

2. <u>TYPE OF FACILITY</u>

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- a) HOTEL Type Room: A room having access from the main lobby, but no direct access from the outside.
- b) MOTEL Type Room: A room in a building sharing a common roof which has direct access from the exterior of the building. Rooms are not linked by an interior corridor.

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c) MOTEL HOTEL OR MOTOR INN - Type Room: A room having access from a main lobby as well as direct access from the exterior of the building. ÷. · ·

d) COMMERCIAL COTTAGES OR CABINS: A self-contained accommodation unit, separated from the other units that does not share a common roof.

3. <u>SIZE OF FACILITY</u>


The number of rooms (accommodation units) that a facility has available for occupancy. Sizes are: 0-12 rooms, 13-25 rooms, 26-75 rooms and 76 rooms or more.

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MANI TOBA ACCOMMODATI ON OCCUPANCY SURVEY 2ND QUARTER, 1990 SUMMARY

i) <u>Mani toba</u>

In the second quarter of 1990 the average occupancy rate for Manitoba is 58.9??, which is a drop of 2.8 percentage points from last year's second quarter occupancy rate of 61.7%. -----

Facilities with more than 75 units have the highest occupancy rate, at 69.6%; 7.6 percentage points lower than in the second quarter of 1989.

Facilities with less than 13 units have an occupancy rate of 30.2%, facilities with 13-25 units have an occupancy rate of 47.4% and facilities with 26-75 units have an occupancy rate of 58.1%.


For the second quarter of 1990 Hotels/Motor Hotels have an occupancy rate of 58.6% compared to 61.1% in the same period last year, and Motels have an occupancy rate of 52.6% compared to 55.3% last year.

ii) <u>Winnipeg</u>

Winnipeg accommodation facilities have an average occupancy rate of 66.6% for the second quarter of 1990, which is a decrease of 5.3 percentage points from the second quarter of 1989.

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Facilities with more than 75 units have the highest occupancy rates for the quarter, at 69.9%; **a** decrease of 6.9 percentage points from the 1989 second quarter figure of 76.8%.

For the second quarter of 1990 Hotels/Motor Hotels in Winnipeg have an occupancy rate of 65.9% compared to 70.1% in the same period last year, but Motels have an occupancy rate of 67.4% compared to 63.0% last year.

iii) <u>Non-Winnipeg</u>

The average second quarter occupancy rate for accommodation facilities outside of Winnipeg is 53.2%, which is a decrease of 0.6 percentage points from the second quarter of 1989.

Facilities with more than 75 units have the highest occupancy rate at 67.4%.

For the second quarter of 1990 Hotels/Motor Hotels outside of Winnipeg have an occupancy rate of 45.4% compared to 47.5% in the same period last year, and Motels have an occupancy rate of 49.0% compared to 53.5% last year.

Commercial Cottages/Cabins have a second quarter occupancy rate of 42.3%, compared to 39.9% in the same period last year.
